In an effort to continue and built upon this collaboration we would like to extend the following scholarships for new students starting in the academic year 2016-2017:

- 25% scholarship for all Embassy employees and their immediate family
- 20% scholarship for all Italian nationals residing in Cyprus and are recommended by the Embassy

These scholarships apply to all the University of Nicosia academic programs (with the exception of the Medicine program) as listed on the second and third page of this letter and provided that the student fulfills the criteria for admission. The above mentioned scholarships relate to the tuition fees of each academic program and will automatically extend to cover all years of study, provided that the student will maintain a Cumulative Average of 2.5 out of 4.0.
